



THE QUEEN CITY



Location & Geography

- Located on the eastern coast of Cebu Island in the Central Visayas region
- Covers about 315 square kilometers
- Bordered by the Cebu Strait to the east, with Mactan Island providing natural harbor protection
- A bustling port city and gateway to numerous scenic islands and beaches in the region

Historical Significance

- Oldest city and first Spanish colonial capital in the Philippines, founded in 1565
- Site of Ferdinand Magellan's 1521 arrival and the first Spanish settlement and Roman Catholic mission in the archipelago
- Rich colonial heritage visible in landmarks such as Magellan's Cross, Fort San Pedro, and Colon Street
- Strong blend of indigenous, Spanish, and modern Filipino influences

Climate

- Tropical monsoon climate with distinct wet and dry seasons
- Year-round average temperatures between 27°C to 29°C (81°F to 84°F)

Culture & People

- Known for warm hospitality and vibrant cultural life
- Influences from indigenous groups, Spanish colonization, and modern Filipino society
- Cebuano (Bisaya) is the primary local language

Economic & Educational Hub

- Major center for commerce, industry, tourism, and education in the Visayas





THE CAPITAL CITY



Location & Geography

- Situated along the eastern shores of Manila Bay, at the mouth of the Pasig River
- Serves as the capital of the Philippines and the core of Metro Manila

Historical Significance

- Originally a Muslim settlement called Maynila, strategically located for trade with neighboring Asian kingdoms like China and Brunei
- Founded as the Spanish colonial capital in 1571 by Miguel López de Legazpi
- Home to the walled city of Intramuros, the political and religious center during Spanish rule
- Crucial hub in the Manila-Acapulco galleon trade route connecting Asia, the Americas, and Europe for over 300 years
- Experienced British occupation in the 18th century and American colonization, influencing its urban planning and development
- Severely damaged during World War II's Battle of Manila, followed by post-war reconstruction transforming it into a modern metropolis

Climate

Tropical climate with warm temperatures year-round

Demographics & Culture

- Predominantly Filipino population, largely Roman Catholic with diverse ethnic and religious minorities including Chinese communities
- A densely populated and rapidly growing urban center

Economic & Educational Hub

- A major center for politics, culture, commerce, and education in the Philippines
- Blends numerous historical landmarks with contemporary city life
